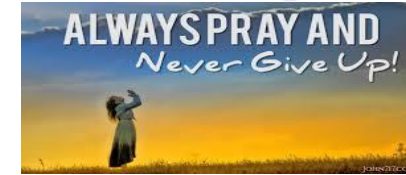


Answered Prayer/Personal Notes
