Prayer Diary - February 2018

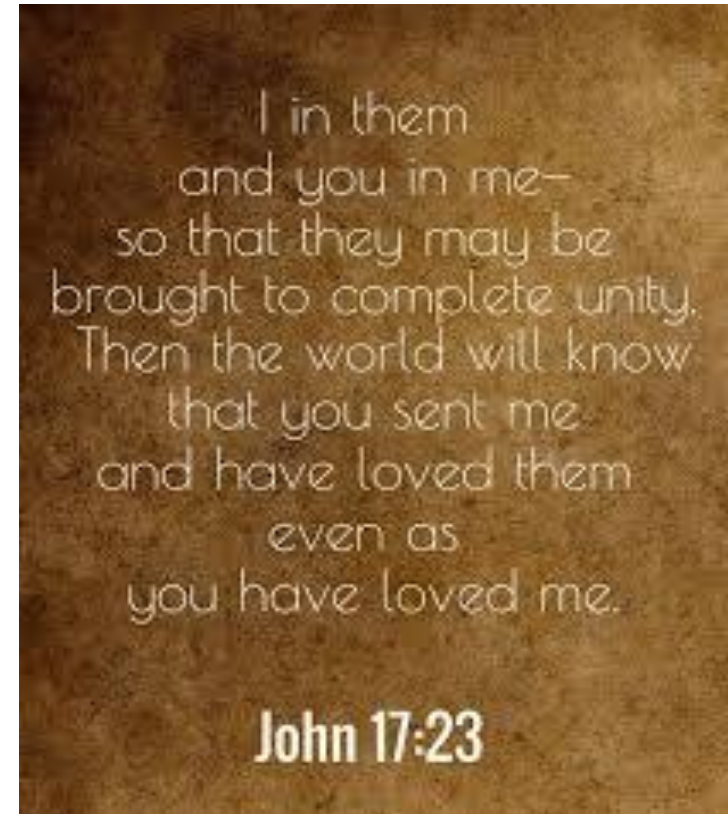
Answered Prayer/Personal Notes
